Other portions were recorded in Hugh Hefner’s Playboy Mansion in Los Angeles. The video captures Vizcaya’s elegance and beauty and will help to promote our community and this unique historic resource to music enthusiasts in Miami and around the world.

About Vizcaya Museum & Gardens

Vizcaya Museum and Gardens is a National Historic Landmark that preserves the Miami estate of agricultural industrialist James Deering to engage our community and its visitors through the arts, history and the environment. Built between 1914 and 1922, Vizcaya is one of the most intact remaining architectural examples from this era in United States

history, when the nation's wealthy industrialists built lavish estates inspired by the palaces of Europe.

Vizcaya features a Main House, 10 acres of formal gardens, a rockland hammock (native forest), mangrove shore and a historic village that will be restored for additional venues for programs and community outreach. Located at 3251 South Miami Avenue between Brickell Avenue and Coconut Grove, Vizcaya is open daily from 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. except Tuesdays, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.
