Three winners will be selected, and the first-place winner will have the honor of seeing his/her design featured as the **Baynanza 2024 commemorative t-shirt!**

PRIZES

**1ST
PLACE**

- › Winning design will be printed on commemorative t-shirt for county-wide distribution.
- › Class of winning student will get a field trip for 35 students to Vizcaya with free admission and transportation for the current school year. The teacher will also receive a Vizcaya membership.
- › Winning student will be awarded at Baynanza's 2024 Kick-Off Reception in February at Vizcaya, and recognized at Baynanza's VIP Site on Saturday, April 13th.

**2ND
PLACE**

- › Winning student will be awarded at Baynanza's 2024 Kick-Off Reception in February at Vizcaya, and will receive a Vizcaya family membership and a framed award.

**3RD
PLACE**

- › Winning student will be awarded at Baynanza's 2024 Kick-Off Reception in February at Vizcaya, and will receive four passes to Vizcaya and a framed award.

DESIGN REQUIREMENTS

- › Design should depict the issues of littering and marine debris in Biscayne Bay.
- › Design must be an original piece that is hand-rendered or created digitally.
- › Design must be 8x11 inches on white unlined paper.
- › Design can be done in full color.
- › Design must be done in colored pencils, pen or fine point markers only.
- › Design must be unframed, unmounted and without a matte.
- › No color graduation allowed.
