Dear Mr. Koch:--

I confirm hereby my day letter to you as follows:

"Have you carefully compared Welte contract with Aeolian contract to see if all specifications, guaranties and everything else are given in the Welte contract that are given in the Aeolian contract except the matter of fewer strings in the Welte as compared with Aeolian already explained to me by Mr. Chalfin. Do you know that Welte organ is as large and powerful and in similar respects equal to the Aeolian? Has your lawyer seen the contract and approved it, together with the letter of Burnham July thirty-first naming date of completion and forfeit? If all these things not done they will necessarily have to be done here."
